Applications accepted from students in Years 3 and 4, 2024

- Set a good example at all times and be a positive role model for all students at Black Hill Primary School, modelling the school values of Resilience, Responsibility, and Respect.
- Remind students at assemblies and through the Blueprint of ways they can help and care for the environment at school and at home.
- Work with the Environmental parents to maintain the garden beds throughout the school.
- Keep the garden beds (vegetable and herb gardens) watered, mulched and weeded.
- Put buckets under bubble taps to collect water for use on the gardens.
- Encourage teachers to use recycled materials for artwork and reuse one-sided paper when possible.
- Meet with the School Council Facilities Sub-Committee to discuss ideas for working bees and other special projects within the yard.
- Assist with the planning, filming and editing of segments for the Blueprint when required.
- Attend a special sit down lunch as a group at the end of the year to celebrate achievements.



Student Leadership 2025 Application Process Environmental Monitors

Blueprint Weeks 2 & 3, Term 4.

Selected current student leaders will discuss the expectations of the leadership roles within the school and their job description outlining the selection process on the Blueprint.

Candidates write a letter to Trish indicating their expression of interest in the position. These are to be given directly to Mrs Westlake. **(Applications close Monday 28th October at 10:00am)**

Between Wednesday 6th November and Friday 29th November

Selected candidates are interviewed by Trish. The following points are considered before a decision is made:

- a) the student's letter of expression of interest,
- b) ability to complete a variety of gardening jobs in the gardens - **sweeping, planting, weeding and mulching.**
- c) teachers' perception of suitability for the role and
- d) Compass Chronicle entries.

Letters to successful and unsuccessful candidates will be sent home **Monday 2nd December**

Student leadership positions will be announced formally at assembly on **Friday 6th December at 2:45pm.**

An induction of all student leaders and badges will be presented at assembly within the first weeks of 2025.

Please note: From your written application the panel will make a shortlist of students who fulfil the key requirements of a student leadership role:

- Wear correct uniform at all times

Students will be notified in writing of the outcome of their applications. (Not all students who apply for positions will be chosen to conduct speeches to the school community or be interviewed).

If you are also applying for other positions, number your preferences by putting 1 for the most important to you, 2 for the next, and so on in the preference column.

Please do not number/apply for more than 4 positions.
