## Application Process Performing Arts Monitors

### Blueprint Weeks 2 & 3, Term 4.

Selected current student leaders will discuss the expectations of the leadership roles within the school and their job description outlining the selection process on the Blueprint.

Candidates write a letter to the Vanessa indicating their expression of interest in the position. These are to be given directly to Mrs Westlake. **(Applications close Monday 28<sup>th</sup> October at 10:00am)**

### By Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November

Students need to submit a video to Vanessa of a dance, drama or music performance of their choice. Students can read a poem or monologue, play an instrument, sing a song etc. to showcase their skills.

In addition, students need to include answers to the following questions in their video:

- What skills or attributes do you have that will benefit you as a Performing Arts Monitor?
- Do you have any suggestions or ideas for extra PA activities in 2025?
- Share this video with Vanessa via USB or on your PA Google Classroom.

Letters to successful and unsuccessful candidates will be sent home **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December.**

Student leadership positions will be announced formally at assembly on **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December at 2:45pm.**

An induction of all student leaders and badges will be presented at assembly within the first weeks of 2025.

Students will be notified in writing of the outcome of their applications. (Not all students who apply for positions will be chosen to conduct speeches to the school community or be interviewed).
