Applications accepted from students in Year 4 and 5, 2024

Roles and responsibilities include:

- To set a good example at all times and be a positive role model for all students at Black Hill Primary School, modelling the school values of Resilience, Responsibility, and Respect.
- To assist with the planning, filming and editing of segments for the Blueprint when required.
- To help organise rosters and volunteer time to organise and upkeep the Art Room.
- To help organise and conduct lunchtime activities and workshops specialising in Visual Arts.
- To put up / take down displays of student work.
- To meet with School Vice-Captains to plan Neighbourhood Gatherings once per term.
- May include special tasks such as:
 - Working on community projects where Black Hill Primary School is involved. For example, art work displays for the Begonia Festival or Begonia Parade, art work displays for the Ballarat Show, assisting specialist teachers with the organisation of Arts Week (even year).
 - Participate in the development of workshops and assist with the organisation of materials, resources and equipment, art works, installations and displays.

Application Process Visual Arts Monitors

Blueprint Weeks 2 & 3, Term 4.

Selected current student leaders will discuss the expectations of the leadership roles within the school and their job description outlining the selection process on the Blueprint.

Candidates write a letter to Jan and Caitlin indicating their expression of interest in the position. These are to be given directly to Mrs Westlake. **(Applications close Monday 28th October at 10:00am)**

Between Wednesday 6th November and Friday 29th November

Selected candidates are interviewed by Jan and Caitlin. The following points are considered before a decision is made:

- a) the student's letter of expression of interest,
- b) the interview,
- c) teachers' perception of suitability for the role and
- d) Compass Chronicle entries.

Letters to successful and unsuccessful candidates will be sent home **Monday 2nd December.**

Student leadership positions will be announced formally at assembly on **Friday 6th December at 2:45pm.**

An induction of all student leaders and badges will be presented at assembly within the first weeks of 2025.

Please address the following questions:

3. Who is a leader that you admire and why do you admire them?
4. What skills could you offer to the Black Hill Primary School community?

Please note: From your written application the panel will make a shortlist of students who fulfil the key requirements of a student leadership role:

- Set a good example
- Model the School Values
- Wear correct uniform at all times

Students will be notified in writing of the outcome of their applications. (Not all students who apply for positions will be chosen to conduct speeches to the school community or be interviewed).

If you are also applying for other positions, number your preferences by putting 1 for the most important to you, 2 for the next, and so on in the preference column.

Please do not number/apply for more than 4 positions.
