- Black Hill Primary School staff will formally recognise the contributions of parents and community members in our school.
- Feedback will be sought from parents as their perceptions regarding parental and community involvement at school via Facebook, Compass, our newsletter, Google Forms and Parent Opinion Survey.
- All parents and community members involved with the school are expected to display our school values; Teamwork, Integrity, Aspiration, Respect and Responsibility when on the school property or involved with students or staff as part of our school programs.
- All parents and community members participating in school programs and activities must provide the school with a copy of their current Working with Children Check and 'sign in' in the visitors book at the office.
